AN ACT TO APPLY CERTAIN SUMS OUT OF THE CENTRAL  
FUND TO THE SERVICE OF THE YEARS ENDING ON  
THE THIRTY-FIRST DAY OF MARCH ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FOUR AND ONE  
10 THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE OIREACHTAS OF SAORSTÁT  
EIREANN AS FOLLOWS:—

1.—The Minister for Finance may issue out of the Central  
Fund and apply towards making good the Supply granted for  
15 the service of the year ending on the thirty-first day of March  
one thousand nine hundred and twenty-four the sum of Three  
Hundred and Thirty-eight Thousand, Eight Hundred and Thirty-  
two Pounds.

2.—The Minister for Finance may issue out of the Central  
Fund and apply towards making good the supply granted for  
20 the service of the year ending on the thirty-first day of March  
one thousand nine hundred and twenty-five the sum of Ten  
Million, Nine Hundred and Nine Thousand, Five Hundred and  
Twenty Pounds.

25 3.—(1) The Minister for Finance may borrow from any person  
and the Bank of Ireland may advance to the Minister for Finance,  
on the credit of the said sums any sum or sums not exceeding in  
the whole Eleven Million, Two Hundred and Forty-eight  
Thousand, Three Hundred and Fifty-two Pounds, and for the  
30 purpose of such borrowing the Minister for Finance may create  
and issue any securities bearing such rate of interest, and subject  
to such conditions as to repayment, redemption or otherwise as  
he thinks fit.

35 (2) The principal and interest of any securities issued under  
this Act and the expenses incurred in connection with the issue  
of such securities shall be charged on the Central Fund or the  
growing produce thereof.

40 (3) Any money raised by securities issued under this Act shall  
be placed to the credit of the account of the Exchequer and shall  
form part of the Central Fund and be available in any manner  
in which such Fund is available.

4.—This Act may be cited as the Central Fund (No. 1) Act, Short Title.  
1924.
