AN ACT TO MAKE FURTHER PROVISION FOR THE
RELIEF OF THE POOR IN THE DUBLIN UNIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE OIREACHTAS OF SAORSTÁT
EIREANN AS FOLLOWS:—

- 20 1.—Notwithstanding anything contained in any enactment limiting the granting of outdoor relief by guardians of the poor to certain classes of persons, it shall be and be deemed always to have been lawful for the Guardians of the Dublin Poor Law Union or the persons for the time being appointed to perform the duties of those guardians to grant subject to such (if any) regulations as may be made by the Minister for Local Government and Public Health and so long as no county scheme relating to the said Union is in operation, outdoor relief to any person in the said Union who is eligible for relief. Extension of outdoor relief in Dublin Poor Lan Union.

- 30 2.—Notwithstanding anything contained in any enactment limiting the granting of outdoor relief by guardians of the poor to certain classes of persons, it shall be and be deemed always to have been lawful for the guardians of the Rathdown Union in the County of Dublin or the persons for the time being appointed to perform the duties of those guardians to grant, subject to such (if any) regulations as may be made by the Minister for Local Government and Public Health, and so long as no county scheme relating to the said Union is in operation, outdoor relief to any person in the said Union who is eligible for relief. Extension of outdoor relief in Rathdown Union.

- 40 3.—Notwithstanding anything contained in any enactment limiting the granting of outdoor relief by guardians of the poor to certain classes of persons, it shall be and be deemed always to have been lawful for the guardians of the Balrothery Union in the County of Dublin, or the persons for the time being appointed to perform the duties of those guardians to grant, subject to such (if any) regulations as may be made by the Minister for Local Government and Public Health, and so long as no county scheme relating to the said Union is in operation, relief to any person in the said Union who is eligible for relief.
