AN ACT TO MAKE FURTHER PROVISION FOR THE RELIEF OF THE POOR IN THE DUBLIN UNIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE OIREACHTAS OF SAORSTAT EIREANN AS FOLLOWS :-

1.—Notwithstanding anything contained in any enactment Extension limiting the granting of outdoor relief by guardians of the poor to of outdoor certain classes of persons, it shall be and be deemed always to have been lawful for the Guardians of the Dublin Poor Law Lan Union. Union or the persons for the time being appointed to perform the

25 duties of those guardians to grant subject to such (if any) regulations as may be made by the Minister for Local Government and Public Health and so long as no county scheme relating to the said Union is in operation, outdoor relief to any person in the said Union who is eligible for relief.

2.-Notwithstanding anything contained in any enactment Extension limiting the granting of outdoor relief by guardians of the poor of outdoor relief in to certain classes of persons, it shall be and be deemed always to have been lawful for the guardians of the Rathdown Union in the Union. County of Dublin or the persons for the time being appointed to 35 perform the duties of those guardians to grant, subject to such

(if any) regulations as may be made by the Minister for Local Government and Public Health, and so long as no county scheme relating to the said Union is in operation, outdoor relief to any person in the said Union who is eligible for relief.

3 .- Notwithstanding anything contained in any enactment Extension limiting the granting of outdoor relief by guardians of the poor of outdoor to certain classes of persons, it shall be and be deemed always to Balrothery have been lawful for the guardians of the Balrothery Union in the Union. County of Dublin, or the persons for the time being appointed to

- 4.—This Act may be cited as the Dublin City and County Short title. (Relief of the Poor) Act, 1929.
