BE IT ENACTED BY THE OIREACHTAS OF SAORSTÁT
EIREANN AS FOLLOWS:—

- 20 1.—Notwithstanding anything contained in any enactment
limiting the granting of outdoor relief by guardians of the poor to
certain classes of persons, it shall be and be deemed always to
have been lawful for the guardians of the poor of any Union
wholly or partly situate in the county or county borough of
Dublin or the persons for the time being appointed to perform the
25 duties of any of those guardians to grant subject to such (if any)
regulations as may be made by the Minister for Local Government
and Public Health outdoor relief to any person in such Union who
is eligible for relief. Extension

- 30 2.—The Minister for Local Government and Public Health may,
in addition to the powers vested in him by the Poor Relief
(Ireland) Acts, 1858 to 1914, make regulations governing the
exercise by a board of guardians of the powers conferred on them
by this Act. Regulations by

- 35 3.—This Act may be cited as the Dublin City and County
(Relief of the Poor) Act, 1929. Short title.
