BE IT ENACTED BY THE OIREACHTAS OF SAORSTAT 20 EIREANN AS FOLLOWS :-

1.—This Act may be cited as the Summary Jurisdiction Short Title. (Punishment in cases of Solicitation) Act, 1932.

2.—(a) So much of section 14 of the Dublin Police Act, 1842 Imprisonment as provides penalties for the following offences, that in lieu of Penalties for is to say, common prostitute or nightwalker loiter- Offences of 25 ing or being in any thoroughfare or public place for Solicitation. the purpose of prostitution or solicitation to the annoyance of the inhabitants or passengers; and

(b) so much of section 28 of the Town Police Clauses Act, 1847 as provides penalties for the following offences, that is to say, common prostitute or nightwalker loitering and importuning passengers for the purpose of prostitution; and

(c) so much of section 72 of the Towns Improvement (Ireland) Act, 1854 as provides penalties for the fol-35 lowing offences, that is to say, common prostitute or nightwalker loitering or importuning passengers for the purpose of prostitution or being otherwise offensive:
