AN ACT TO TRANSFER REGISTRATION APPEALS IN THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DUBLIN AND IN UNIVERSITY CONSTITUENCIES FROM THE REVIS-ING BARRISTERS TO THE CIRCUIT COURT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE OIREACHTAS OF SAORSTAT EIREANN AS FOLLOWS :-

Definitions.

- 1.—(1) In this Act the expression "Principal Act" means the Electoral Act, 1923 (No. 12 of 1923).
- (2) All words and expressions used in this Act which are also 15 used in the Principal Act shall, unless the context otherwise requires, have the same meaning in this Act as they respectively have in the Principal Act.

Registration appeals in Dublin and university constituencies.

2,—(1) In the county borough of Dublin, and in a university constituency, and in the county of Dublin the appeal under 20 section 16 of the Principal Act from the registration officer shall be to the Judge of the Circuit Court exercising the jurisdiction of that Court in the registration area of such registration officer, and the said section (so far as it is not repealed by this Act or any previous Act) shall apply to such appeals subject to the 25 modifications that references to the County Court, the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, and the Court of Appeal respectively shall be construed and have effect as references to the Circuit Court, the Chief Justice of Saorstát Eireann, and the Supreme Court respectively.

(2) For the purposes of the said section 16 as applied by this section, the registration area of a university constituency shall be deemed to be situate in the City of Dublin.

Repeals.

3.—The enactments mentioned in the Schedule to this Act are hereby repealed to the extent specified in the third column of that 35 Schedule.

Short title.

4.—This Act may be cited as the Electoral (Registration Appeals) Act. 1932.
