AN ACT TO TRANSFER REGISTRATION APPEALS IN  
THE CITY AND COUNTY OF DUBLIN AND IN  
UNIVERSITY CONSTITUENCIES FROM THE REVIS-  
ING BARRISTERS TO THE CIRCUIT COURT. 10

BE IT ENACTED BY THE OIREACHTAS OF SAORSTÁT  
EIREANN AS FOLLOWS:—

**Definitions.**

1.—(1) In this Act the expression “ Principal Act ” means the  
Electoral Act, 1923 (No. 12 of 1923).

(2) All words and expressions used in this Act which are also 15  
used in the Principal Act shall, unless the context otherwise  
requires, have the same meaning in this Act as they respectively  
have in the Principal Act.

2.—(1) In the county borough of Dublin, and in a university  
constituency, and in the county of Dublin the appeal under 20  
section 16 of the Principal Act from the registration officer shall  
be to the Judge of the Circuit Court exercising the jurisdiction  
of that Court in the registration area of such registration officer,  
and the said section (so far as it is not repealed by this Act or  
any previous Act) shall apply to such appeals subject to the 25  
modifications that references to the County Court, the Chief  
Justice of the Supreme Court, and the Court of Appeal respec-  
tively shall be construed and have effect as references to the  
Circuit Court, the Chief Justice of Saorstát Eireann, and the  
Supreme Court respectively. 30

(2) The said section 16, in its application to the registration of  
local government electors pursuant to the Local Government  
Electors Registration Act, 1924 (No. 7 of 1924), shall have effect  
subject to the provisions of this Act.

(3) For the purposes of the said section 16 as applied by this 35  
section, the registration area of a university constituency shall  
be deemed to be situate in the City of Dublin.

**Repeals.**

3.—The enactments mentioned in the Schedule to this Act are  
hereby repealed to the extent specified in the third column of that  
Schedule. 40

**Short title.**

4.—This Act may be cited as the Electoral (Registration  
Appeals) Act, 1932.
