AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4 OF THE SCHOOL  
 ATTENDANCE ACT, 1926.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE OIREACHTAS OF SAORSTÁT  
 EIREANN AS FOLLOWS:—

1.—In this Act the expression “the Principal Act” means the  
 School Attendance Act, 1926 (No. 17 of 1926). The Principal  
Act.

2.—(1) Sub-sections (3) and (4) of section 4 of the Principal  
 20 Act are hereby amended by the substitution in each of those sub-  
 sections of the words “the year 1941” for the words “the year  
 1936.” Amendment of  
sub-sections (3)  
and (4) of  
section 4 of  
Principal Act.

(2) This section shall have and be deemed to have had effect as  
 from the commencement of the said section 4.

25 3.—This Act may be cited as the School Attendance Act, 1936,  
 and the Principal Act and this Act may be cited together as the  
 School Attendance Acts 1926 and 1936. Short title and  
citation.
