15 AN ACT TO EXTEND, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SECURING THE PUBLIC SAFETY AND THE PRESERVATION OF THE STATE IN TIME OF WAR, THE PERIOD DURING WHICH THE EMERGENCY POWERS ACT, 1939, SHALL REMAIN IN FORCE.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE OIREACHTAS AS FOLLOWS :—

1.—In this Act the expression “ the Principal Act ” means the Emergency Powers Act, 1939 (No. 28 of 1939). The Principal Act.

2.—(1) The Principal Act shall, unless previously terminated under sub-section (2) of this section, continue in force until the 25 2nd day of September, 1944, and shall then expire unless the Oireachtas otherwise determines. Continuance of the Principal Act.

(2) The Government may by order declare that the Principal Act shall expire on a specified date, being earlier than the 2nd day of September, 1944, and in that case the Principal Act shall 30 expire accordingly.

3.—Section 4 of the Emergency Powers (Continuance and Amendment) Act, 1942 (No. 19 of 1942), is hereby repealed. Repeal of section 4 of the Emergency Powers (Continuance and Amendment) Act, 1942.

4.—This Act may be cited as the Emergency Powers Short title. (Continuance) Act, 1943.
