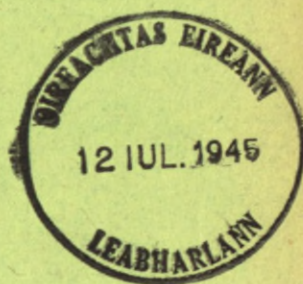

## SECTION 7.

1. At the end of subsection (1) to add the following words:—  
“and such leases shall be made only to the company and to no other person or persons.”

## SECTION 8.

2. In line 30, subsection (1), to delete the words “any person” and substitute therefor the words “the company”.—James Hughes, Liam Cosgrave.

## SECTION 13.

3. In subsection (2), before paragraph (d), to insert the following paragraph:—

“the Articles shall provide that for the purpose of constituting the company, the Bloodstock Breeders’ and Horse Owners’ Association of Ireland shall select and provide a panel of twelve persons who are in the opinion of the Association persons suitable to act as directors of the company and appointments to the Board shall only be made from this panel.

For the purpose of filling any vacancy or vacancies that may arise from time to time the Association shall submit a panel of three names for each such vacancy and the responsible Minister shall select a person or persons from the panel to fill such vacancy or vacancies.”

4. In sub-section (2), to delete paragraph (d), and substitute therefor the following new paragraph:—

“the Minister for Finance shall reimburse directors of the company for any actual out of pocket expenses incurred by them in connection with the business of the company.”

## SECTION 25.

5. In line 27, subsection (5), to delete the word “activities” and substitute the words “policy, activities and decisions”.—James Hughes, Liam Cosgrave.

6. At the end of subsection (5) to add the following words:—  
“and shall be responsible to him for the proper and efficient conduct of its business.”

—James Hughes, Liam Cosgrave.

7. Before subsection (6) to insert a new subsection as follows:—

“The Minister shall at all times be responsible to both Houses of the Oireachtas for the policy of the company and the conduct of its affairs.”
