SECTION 5.

1. In paragraph (a), after line 27, to insert a new subparagraph as follows:—
“ (iv) discovering technical processes and methods which may promote the expansion or development of agriculture.”

2. In paragraph (c), after the word “analyse” in line 33, to insert the words “either through itself or through the medium of authorised agents.”—Senator Sir John Keane.
3. In paragraph (c), lines 33-34, to delete the words “intended for sale or for use by the public.”—Senator Sir John Keane.

SECTION 8.

4. In subsection (2), after the word “members” in line 20, to insert the words “four of whom shall be nominated by the Council and five appointed by the Minister.”—Senator Sir John Keane.

SECTION 11.

5. In subsection (2), line 42, after the word “members” to insert the words “three of whom shall be nominated by the Council and four appointed by the Minister and.”—Senator Sir John Keane.

SECTION 38.

6. In subsection (1), line 46, to delete the words “Industrial Research Committee” and substitute the word “Director”.
—Senator Sir John Keane.
7. In subsection (2), lines 51-52, to delete the words “to the Director”; and in line 52, to delete the words “as the Director” and substitute the words “as the Committee”.
