BE IT ENACTED BY THE OIREACHTAS AS FOLLOWS:-

Principal Act.

1.—In this Act, the expression "the Principal Act" means the Connaught Rangers (Pensions) Act, 1936 (No. 37 of 1936).

Amendment of section 18 (1) of Principal Act.

2.—(1) Subsection (1) of section 18 of the Principal Act shall have effect as if, for the Third Schedule to that Act, there were substituted the following :-

RULES FOR CALCULATION OF SUSPENSION OF SERVICE PENSIONS.
