AN ACT TO CONTINUE FOR A LIMITED PERIOD CERTAIN EXPIRING ENACTMENTS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE OIREACHTAS AS FOLLOWS:-

- 1.—(1) The Acts mentioned in the Schedule to this Act shall, Acts in Schedule to the extent specified in the third column of the said Schedule, to be continued. be continued until the 31st day of December, 1950, and shall then expire unless further continued.
- (2) Any unrepealed enactments amending or affecting the enactments continued by this section shall, in so far as they are 20 temporary in their duration, be continued in like manner whether they are mentioned in the Schedule to this Act or not.
  - 2.—This Act may be cited as the Expiring Laws Act, 1949.
