AN ACT TO AMEND AND EXTEND THE LICENSING 5
(IRELAND) ACTS, 1833 TO 1943.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE OIREACHTAS AS FOLLOWS :—

Short title,
construction and
collective citation.

1.—(1) This Act may be cited as the Intoxicating Liquor
(Amendment) Act, 1950.

(2) This Act shall be construed as one with the Licensing (Ire- 10
land) Acts, 1833 to 1943, and may be cited with these Acts as the
Licensing Acts, 1833 to 1950.

Definitions.

2.—In this Act—

the expression “the Act of 1927 ” means the Intoxicating Liquor 15
Act, 1927 (No. 15 of 1927);

the expression “the Act of 1943 ” means the Intoxicating Liquor
Act, 1943 (No. 7 of 1943).

Amendment of
section 2 of
Act of 1927.

3.—Section 2 of the Act of 1927 as amended by section 4 of
the Act of 1943 is hereby amended by the deletion of paragraphs
(a) and (b) of subsection (2) thereof and the insertion therein of 20
the following paragraphs in lieu of the said paragraphs so deleted,
and the said Act of 1927 as amended by the said Act of 1943 shall
be construed and have effect accordingly, that is to say :—

(a) on any week-day—

(i) during a period of summer time, before the hour 25
of half-past ten o'clock in the morning or after the
hour of half-past ten o'clock in the evening, or

(ii) during any period which is not a period of summer
time, before the hour of ten o'clock in the morning
or after the hour of ten o'clock in the evening, or 30

(b) on any Sunday before the hour of one o'clock in the after-
noon or between the hours of three o'clock in the after-
noon and seven o'clock in the evening, or after the
hour of nine o'clock in the evening;

(c) at any time on Christmas Day, Good Friday, or Saint 35
Patrick's Day.
