AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR INCREASES IN THE RATES 5
OF PENSIONS UNDER THE OLD AGE PENSIONS ACTS,
1908 TO 1955, UNEMPLOYMENT ASSISTANCE UNDER
THE UNEMPLOYMENT ASSISTANCE ACTS, 1933 TO
1952, AND WIDOWS' (NON-CONTRIBUTORY) PENSIONS
UNDER THE WIDOWS' AND ORPHANS' PENSIONS 10
ACTS, 1935 TO 1955.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE OIREACHTAS AS FOLLOWS :—

Increase of
rates of old
age pensions.

1.—(1) The rates of 24s. 0d., 19s. 0d., 14s. 0d. and 9s. 0d. set
forth in the Table to subsection (2) of section 77 of the Social
Welfare Act, 1952 (No. 11 of 1952), by virtue of section 1 of the 15
Social Welfare Act, 1955 (No. 11 of 1955), are each hereby increased
by 1s. 0d.

(2) Subsection (1) of this section shall be deemed to have come
into operation on the 17th May, 1957.

2.—(1) In the Unemployment Assistance Act, 1933 (No. 46 of 20
1933), for the Schedule thereto inserted by subsection (1) of section
97 of the Social Welfare Act, 1952 (No. 11 of 1952), there is hereby
substituted the following :—

- (4) The Widows' and Orphans' Pensions Acts, 1935 to 1955, and section 3 of this Act may be cited together as the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions Acts, 1935 to 1957.
