AN BILLE PRIOMH-CHISTE, 1958 CENTRAL FUND BILL, 1958

AN ACT TO APPLY CERTAIN SUMS OUT OF THE CENTRAL 5 FUND TO THE SERVICE OF THE YEARS ENDING ON THE THIRTY-FIRST DAY OF MARCH ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTY-EIGHT AND ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTY-NINE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE OIREACHTAS AS FOLLOWS: - 10

Issue of the Central Fund for the service of the year ending 31st March, 1958.

1.—The Minister for Finance may issue out of the Central Fund £8,055,637 out of and apply towards making good the supply granted for the service of the year ending on the thirty-first day of March one thousand nine hundred and fifty-eight, the sum of Eight Million Fifty-five Thousand Six Hundred and Thirty-seven Pounds.

Issue of £36,500,000 out of the Central Fund for the service of the year ending 31st March, 1959.

2.—The Minister for Finance may issue out of the Central Fund and apply towards making good the supply granted for the service of the year ending on the thirty-first day of March one thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine, the sum of Thirty-six Million Five Hundred Thousand Pounds.

Power of Minister for Finance to borrow up to £44,555,637.

3.—(1) The Minister for Finance may borrow from any person and the Bank of Ireland may advance to the Minister for Finance any sum or sums not exceeding in the whole Forty-four Million Five Hundred and Fifty-five Thousand Six Hundred and Thirtyseven Pounds and for the purpose of such borrowing the Minister 25 for Finance may create and issue any securities bearing such rate of interest and subject to such conditions as to repayment, redemption or otherwise as he thinks fit.

(2) The principal and interest of any securities issued under this Act and the expenses incurred in connection with the issue of such 30 securities shall be charged on the Central Fund or the growing produce thereof.

(3) Any money raised by securities issued under this Act shall be placed to the credit of the account of the Exchequer and shall form part of the Central Fund and be available in any manner 35 in which such Fund is available.

Short title.

4.—This Act may be cited as the Central Fund Act, 1958.
