**EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

1. These measures are designed to give statutory effect to the increases in pensions and allowances which were outlined by the Minister for Finance in his 1963 Budget Statement. Payment commenced with effect from the 1st November, 1963 on the authority of a Supplementary Estimate approved by Dáil Éireann on the 28th November, 1963.

2. With regard to the Army Pensions (Increase) Bill, the pensions of officers who retired before the 16th December, 1959 and whose pensions are related to their Army pay on retirement are brought up to the rates hitherto appropriate to officers of similar rank and service who retired on the 16th December, 1959. Pensions which are not related to pay and married or further pensions are increased by 5 per cent, as are also allowances payable to relatives and dependants. In the case of special allowances, the "appropriate annual sum" is in each instance increased by £4 (*section 26*).

3. The three other measures provide for the increase by 5 per cent. of the pensions to which they relate.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

1. These measures are designed to give statutory effect to the increases in pensions and allowances which were outlined by the Minister for Finance in his 1963 Budget Statement. Payment commenced with effect from the 1st November, 1963 on the authority of a Supplementary Estimate approved by Dail Eireann on the 29th November, 1963.

2. With regard to the Army Pensions (Increase) Bill, the pensions of officers who retired before the 1st December, 1958 and whose pensions are payable to their Army pay on retirement are brought up to the rates payable to officers in similar rank and service who retired on the 1st December, 1958. Pensions which are not related to pay and awarded on further pensions are increased by 5 per cent and are also allowances payable to relatives and dependants. In the case of special allowances, the "appropriate annual sum" in each instance increased by 5 per cent.

3. The three other measures provide for the increase by 5 per cent of the pensions to which they relate.
