ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

Section

1. Restriction of Control of Manufactures Acts, 1932 and 1934.
2. Repeal of Control of Manufactures Acts, 1932 and 1934, and Industrial Development (Encouragement of External Investment) Act, 1958.
3. Short title and collective citation.

1.—(1) The Control of Manufactures Acts, 1932 and 1934, shall not apply in relation to—

(a) a company which during the five years immediately preceding the date of the passing of this Act, carried on continuously in the State in compliance with those Acts as amended by the Industrial Development (Encouragement of External Investment) Act, 1958, a manufacturing process or

(b) a company of which—

(i) the issued shares to an extent exceeding one-half (in nominal value), and

(ii) at least two-thirds (in nominal value) of every class of shares carrying voting rights (whether immediate or to arise in certain future circumstances),

are in the beneficial ownership of a company which during the five years immediately preceding the date of the passing of this Act, carried on continuously in the State in compliance with those Acts as amended as a manufacturing process.

(2) In this section—

“company” means a company established either before or after the passing of this Act and either within or without the State;

“manufacturing process” means—

(a) the making by the use of mechanical power, of a commodity;

(b) the altering by the use of mechanical power, of a commodity;

(c) the ornamenting by the use of mechanical power, of a commodity.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CONTROL OF MANUFACTURES 5
ACTS, 1932 AND 1934, AND TO REPEAL PROSPECT-
IVELY THOSE ACTS AND THE INDUSTRIAL
DEVELOPMENT (ENCOURAGEMENT OF EXTERNAL
INVESTMENT) ACT, 1958.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE OIREACHTAS AS FOLLOWS :-- 10

Restriction of
Control of
Manufactures
Acts, 1932 and
1934.

1.—(1) The Control of Manufactures Acts, 1932 and 1934, shall
not apply in relation to—

(a) a company which, during the five years immediately
preceding the date of the passing of this Act, carried on
continuously in the State in compliance with those Acts, 15
as amended by the Industrial Development (Encourage-
ment of External Investment) Act, 1958, a manufac-
turing process, or

1958, No. 16.

(b) a company of which—

(i) the issued shares to an extent exceeding one-half 20
(in nominal value), and

(ii) at least two-thirds (in nominal value) of every class
of shares carrying voting rights (whether
immediate or to arise in certain future circum-
stances), 25

are in the beneficial ownership of a company which,
during the five years immediately preceding the date
of the passing of this Act, carried on continuously in
the State in compliance with those Acts, as amended
as aforesaid, a manufacturing process. 30

(2) In this section—

“ company ” means a company established either before or after
the passing of this Act and either within or without the State;

“ manufacturing process ” means—

(a) the making, by the use of mechanical power, of a 35
commodity,

(b) the altering, by the use of mechanical power, of a
commodity,

(c) the ornamenting, by the use of mechanical power, of a
commodity, 40

(d) the finishing, by the use of mechanical power, of a commodity, or

(e) the adapting for sale, by the use of mechanical power, of a commodity.

5 2.—(1) The Control of Manufactures Acts, 1932 and 1934, and the Industrial Development (Encouragement of External Investment) Act, 1958, are hereby repealed.

(2) Subsection (1) of this section shall come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1968.

10 3.—(1) This Act may be cited as the Control of Manufactures Act, 1964.

Short title and collective citation

(2) The Control of Manufactures Acts, 1932 and 1934, the Industrial Development (Encouragement of External Investment) Act, 1958, and this Act may be cited together as the Control of

15 Manufactures Acts, 1932 to 1964.
