ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

AN ACT TO AMEND AND EXTEND THE TOURIST TRAFFIC 5 ACTS, 1939 TO 1970. NOTE: 1939 TO 1970.

- 1. Increase of non-repayable grants to Bord Fáilte Éireann.
- 2. Short title and collective citation.

1.—(1) The aggregate amount of the sums that the Minister for Transport and Power may pay to Bord Fadde Sincann for the development of major neurits results shall not exceed £4,000,000 and, accordingly, section 2 (1) (a) of the Tomist Traffic Act, 1959, shall be construed as if that sum were substituted for the sum of £3,250,000 meaninged therein and inversed by rection 5 (1) (a) of the Tourist Traffic Act, 1955.

(2) The approprie amount of the sums that the Minister for 15 Transport and Power may pay to Bord Pailte Eircean for the purpose of the giving of grants by Bord Pailte Eircean for the development of helding accommodation shall not exceed £13,000,000 and, accordingly, section 2 (1) (6) of the Tourist Traine Act, 1959, shall be construed as if that sum were substituted for the sum of 20 £11,000,000 mentioned therein and inserted by section 2 of the Tourist Traine Act, 1970.

-(1) This Acc may be cited as the Pourist Traffic Act, 1972.

(2) The Towist Traffic Acts, 1939 to 1970, and this Act may be cited together as the Towist Traffic Acts, 1939 to 1972.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE OIREACHTAS AS FOLLOWS:

Increase of non-repayable grants to Bord Fáilte Eireann. 1959, No. 27. 1966, No. 3. 1.—(1) The aggregate amount of the sums that the Minister for Transport and Power may pay to Bord Fáilte Éireann for the development of major tourist resorts shall not exceed £4,000,000 and, accordingly, section 2 (1) (a) of the Tourist Traffic Act, 1959, shall be construed as if that sum were substituted for the sum of £3,250,000 mentioned therein and inserted by section 6 (1) (a) of the Tourist Traffic Act, 1966.

(2) The aggregate amount of the sums that the Minister for 15 Transport and Power may pay to Bord Fáilte Éireann for the purpose of the giving of grants by Bord Fáilte Éireann for the development of holiday accommodation shall not exceed £13,000,000 and, accordingly, section 2 (1) (b) of the Tourist Traffic Act, 1959, shall be construed as if that sum were substituted for the sum of 20 £11,000,000 mentioned therein and inserted by section 2 of the Tourist Traffic Act, 1970.
