### AN ACT TO AMEND AND EXTEND THE FOIR TEORANTA 5 ACT, 1972.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE OIREACHTAS AS FOLLOWS:

2.- The aggregate at any one time of the borrowings (including

borrowings from the Minister and borrowing for any of the purposes

of the Company which are consequent upon section 19 of the Principal Act, but excluding borrowings by Taiscí Stáit Teoranta)

shall not exceed £17,500,000, and, accordingly, section 12 (b) of the Principal Act shall be construed as if that sum were substituted for

3.—The aggregate at any one time of advances to the Company

by the Minister (including advances for the purposes of any of the

functions of the Company which are consequent upon section 19 of the Principal Act, but excluding advances made to Taiscí Stáit Teoranta) which have not been repaid shall not exceed £17,500,000, and, accordingly, section 13 (3) of the Principal Act shall be construed as if that sum were substituted for the sum mentioned therein. 25


