BE IT ENACTED BY THE OIREACHTAS AS FOLLOWS:

1.—Section 28 of the Redundancy Payments Act, 1967, which specifies the amount of weekly contributions to the Redundancy Fund, is hereby amended by the insertion after subsection (3) of the following new subsection: 10

“(3A) Notwithstanding anything in section 27 or this section of this Act, a redundancy contribution shall not be payable by an employed contributor (within the meaning of the Social Welfare Act, 1952) who is in receipt of a widow’s (contributory) pension, a widow’s (non-contributory) pension, deserted wife’s benefit, a deserted wife’s allowance or a social assistance allowance under section 8 of the Social Welfare Act, 1973.” 15

2.—(1) This Act may be cited as the Redundancy Payments Act, 1973. 20

(2) The Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 and 1971, and this Act may be cited together as the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 1973.

(3) This Act shall come into operation on such day as the Minister appoints by order. 25

1. Section 28 of the Redundancy Payments Act, 1967, which
specifies the amount of weekly contributions to the Redundancy
Fund, is hereby amended by the insertion after subsection (1) of the
following subsection:

(3A) Notwithstanding anything in section 27 or this section
of this Act, a redundancy contribution shall not be payable by
an employee contributor (within the meaning of the Social Wel-
fare Act, 1952) who is in receipt of a widow's (contributory) or
widow's (non-contributory) pension, a deserted wife's
pension, a deserted wife's allowance or a social assistance allow-
ance under section 3 of the Social Welfare Act, 1973.
