(ACCEPTANCE OF TRUSTEESHIP) BILL, 1978**

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

1. Interpretations.

2. Under this section the Commissioners of Public Works will have power to act as trustees of the Barretstown Castle Trust set up to manage Barretstown Castle and lands which are available for use by the State under that Trust.

3. The Commissioners of Public Works under this section will have power to act as trustees in the case of any future trusts subject to the consent of the Minister for Finance.

4. This section clarifies the position of land held in trust by the Commissioners of Public Works. Land held in trust is intended normally for use for the benefit of the trust while State land is land accepted by the Government or a State authority for the benefit of the State.
