AN ACT TO ENABLE THE NUMBER OF ORDINARY JUDGES 5
OF THE HIGH COURT TO BE NOT MORE THAN
FOURTEEN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE OIREACHTAS AS FOLLOWS:

1.—The number of ordinary judges of the High Court shall not be 10
more than fourteen.

Consequential.

2.—The following paragraph shall be substituted for paragraph (b)
(inserted by the Courts Act, 1979) of section 14 (1) of the Law Reform
Commission Act, 1975:

“(b) in case on being so appointed he is the President of the High
Court or an ordinary judge of the High Court, then for so 15
long as he continues to hold the judicial office held by him
on so being appointed—

(i) the number of ordinary judges of the High Court shall
not be more than fifteen, and

(ii) the reference in *section 1* of the *Courts (No. 2) Act*, 20
1981, to fourteen shall be construed as a reference to
fifteen, and”.

Repeal.

3.—Section 1 of the Courts Act, 1979, is hereby repealed.
