AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE TO THE PROPER SUPPLY SER- 5
VICES AND PURPOSES SUMS GRANTED BY THE CENTRAL FUND (PERMANENT PROVISIONS) ACT, 1965.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE OIREACHTAS AS FOLLOWS:—

1.—(1) The sums granted by the Central Fund (Permanent Pro- 10
visions) Act, 1965, out of the Central Fund towards making good the
supply granted, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of six thousand,
one hundred and fifty million, seven hundred and forty-seven thou-
sand pounds for the service of the year ending on the 31st day of
December, 1985, are appropriated for the services and purposes
expressed in the *Schedule* hereto. 15

(2) In addition to the grants out of the Central Fund referred to in
the foregoing subsection of this section, there may be applied out of
any money directed under section 2 of the Public Accounts and
Charges Act, 1891, to be applied as appropriations-in-aid of the grants
for the services and purposes specified in the *Schedule* hereto, the sums 20
respectively set forth in *column (4)* of the said *Schedule* amounting, as
appears thereby, in the aggregate to the sum of five hundred and
thirty-five million, three hundred and sixty-four thousand pounds.

Short title.

2.—This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, 1985.
