AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN ACTIONS IN THE 5
HIGH COURT SHALL NOT BE TRIED WITH A JURY
AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS. 10

BE IT ENACTED BY THE OIREACHTAS AS FOLLOWS:

Abolition of juries
in certain actions
in High Court.

1.—(1) Notwithstanding section 94 of the Courts of Justice Act, 1924, or any other enactment or rule of law, an action in the High Court—

- (a) for the recovery of damages for personal injuries to any person,
- (b) under section 48 of the Civil Liability Act, 1961, or
- (c) under section 18 (inserted by the Air Navigation and Transport Act, 1965) of the Air Navigation and Transport Act, 1936, 15

or a question of fact or an issue arising in such an action, shall not be tried with a jury.

(2) In *subsection (1)* of this section— 20

- (a) the reference to an action for the recovery of damages for personal injuries to any person shall be construed as a reference to an action claiming damages for negligence, nuisance or breach of duty (whether the duty exists by virtue of a contract or of a provision made by or under a statute or independently of any contract or any such provision) where the damages claimed by the plaintiff for the negligence, nuisance or breach of duty consist of or include damages in respect of personal injuries to any person, but shall not include an action where the damages claimed include damages for false imprisonment, or for intentional trespass to the person; 25 30
- (b) “personal injuries” includes any disease and any impairment of a person’s physical or mental condition.

2.—Section 18 (2) (inserted by the Air Navigation and Transport Act, 1965) of the Air Navigation and Transport Act, 1936, is hereby amended by the deletion in paragraphs (f) and (k) of “the jury or” and “, as the case may be,”.

5 3.—Section 49 (1) (a) of the Civil Liability Act, 1961, is hereby amended by the deletion in subparagraph (i) of “the jury or” and “, as the case may be,”.

Amendment of Civil Liability Act, 1961.

4.—(1) This Act may be cited as the Courts Act, 1986.

Short title, collective citation, construction and application.

10 (2) The Courts (Supplemental Provisions) Acts, 1961 to 1985, and this Act may be cited together as the Courts (Supplemental Provisions) Acts, 1961 to 1986, and shall be construed together as one.

(3) This Act shall not apply in relation to any proceedings in which notice of trial has been served or given before the passing of this Act.
