EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

- 1. This Bill will raise the aggregate limits on voted monies that can be provided to Bord Fáilte for grant aiding tourist development with a view to improving the Irish tourism product.
- 2. Section 2 (1) increases the aggregate limit on grant aid for accommodation from £30 to £36 million and section 2 (2) increases the limit for grant aid for other tourist amenities from £14 to £18 million.
- 3. Bord Fáilte development funds continue to be subject to review each year and must be voted annually by the Oireachtas. This Bill extends the limits up to which amounts of such capital funds Voted annually are allowed to accumulate.
- 4. The limits were last revised in 1983 in the Tourist Traffic Act of the same year.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM
