AN ACT TO AMEND THE DESTRUCTIVE INSECTS AND PESTS (CONSOLIDATION) ACT, 1958.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE OIREACHTAS AS FOLLOWS:

"Principal Act".

1.—In this Act "the Principal Act" means the Destructive Insects 10 and Pests (Consolidation) Act, 1958.

2.—(1) A person who contravenes or fails to comply with an order

(2) The power conferred on the Minister to make an order under the said section 2 or 3 shall include power to provide in the order for 15 such incidental, supplementary and consequential provisions as shall appear to the Minister to be necessary for giving full effect to any

Penalties.

4.—A person guilty of an offence under section 2 of this Act or section 8 of the Principal Act shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £1,000 or to imprisonment for a term not 30 exceeding 3 months or to both.

Offences by directors etc., of bodies corporate. 5.—Where an offence under section 2 of this Act or section 8 of the Principal Act is committed by a body corporate and is proved to have been so committed with the consent, connivance or approval of or to have been attributable to any neglect on the part of any person, 35

being a director, manager, secretary or other officer of the body corporate or a person who was purporting to act in any such capacity, that person, as well as the body corporate, shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to be proceeded against and punished as if he were guilty of the first-mentioned offence.

6.—Subsections (2) (e) and (3) of section 3 of the Principal Act are Repeals. hereby repealed.

7.—(1) This Act may be cited as the Destructive Insects and Pests Short title, (Amendment) Act, 1990.

Short title, collective citation, construction and commencement.

10 (2) The Principal Act and this Act may be cited together as the Destructive Insects and Pests Acts, 1958 and 1990, and shall be construed together as one.

(3) This Act shall come into operation one month after the date of its passing.
