EXPLANATORY AND FINANCIAL MEMORANDUM

BILL

1. The Bill provides that, in the interpretation of legislation (and administrative instruments) the contrary intention appears, the feminine gender shall be construed as also importing the masculine gender. It is intended to facilitate the drafting of statutory instruments in the future gender neutral language.
