EXPLANATORY AND FINANCIAL MEMORANDUM

1. The Bill provides that, in the interpretation of legislation generally, unless the contrary intention appears, an expression in the feminine gender shall be construed as also importing the masculine gender. This is intended to facilitate the drafting of Bills and Statutory Instruments in the feminine gender where appropriate.
