EXPLANATORY AND FINANCIAL MEMORANDUM

General

The purpose of the Bill is to increase the membership of the Board and to provide that one ordinary member shall be appointed on the nomination of the Minister for the Marine.

Specific provisions

Section 1 provides that the minimum number of ordinary members shall be increased from nine to eleven and the maximum number from eleven to thirteen. It also provides that one ordinary member shall be appointed on the nomination of the Minister for the Marine as well as for certain consequential changes in the provisions governing the terms of office of the first Board members.

Section 2 provides for the short title and collective citation of the Bill.

Financial Implications

The proposals in this Bill have no staffing implications. There are no financial implications other than fees and expenses for the additional Board members.
