AN ACT TO AMEND THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT  
 ACT, 2000 TO MAKE PROVISION FOR A MANDATORY  
 REQUIREMENT TO PRESERVE AND LIST PUBLIC  
 RIGHTS OF WAY, INCLUDING, IN PARTICULAR,  
 RIGHTS OF WAY WHICH GIVE ACCESS TO THE SEA-  
 SHORE, MOUNTAIN, LAKESHORE, RIVERBANK OR  
 OTHER PLACE OF NATURAL BEAUTY OR REC-  
 REATIONAL UTILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE OIREACHTAS AS FOLLOWS:

**1.**—This Act may be cited as the Planning and Development Short Title.  
 (Amendment) (No. 2) Act 2004.

**2.**—This Act comes into operation one month after the date of Commencement.  
 its passing.

**3.**—Section 10 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 is Amendment of  
 amended by inserting the following after paragraph (2)(m)— Chapter 1, section  
 10 of Planning and  
 Development Act  
 2000.  
 “(n) the preservation and listing of existing public rights of way,  
 including, in particular, rights of way which give access to  
 the seashore, mountain, lakeshore, riverbank or other  
 place of natural beauty or recreational utility.”.

**4.**—First Schedule of the Planning and Development Act 2000 is Amendment of  
 amended by deleting Part IV, paragraph 8— First Schedule, Part  
 IV, paragraph 8 of  
 Planning and  
 Development Act  
 2000.  
 “8. Preserving any existing public right of way, including, in  
 particular, rights of way which give access to seashore, mountain,  
 lakeshore, riverbank or other place of natural beauty or rec-  
 reational utility.”.
