

# AN BILLE UM CHLÁRÚ SIBHIALTA (LEASÚ) 2005 CIVIL REGISTRATION (AMENDMENT) BILL 2005

#### EXPLANATORY AND FINANCIAL MEMORANDUM

General

The Bill provides for an amendment to the Civil Registration Act 2004, to permit the continued payment of specified fees and allowances to registrars of births, deaths and marriages who are not employed by the Health Service Executive, and to persons employed by the Health Service Executive who are not assigned as registrars on a full-time basis to the office of a Superintendent Registrar.

Upon commencement of any parts (other than parts 1 & 2) of the Civil Registration Act 2004, the existing provisions for payment of fees and allowances to these registrars will be repealed. Commencement must include the relevant repeals to avoid duplication and possible conflict of legislation.

## Provisions of the Bill

The Bill contains one substantive provision (Section (1)) to amend the 2004 Act. This provision will allow for the continued payment of specified fees and allowances.

Section (2) of the Bill contains standard provisions in legislation, i.e. short title and collective citation.

# Financial Implications

It is not expected that the Act will give rise to any additional costs.

# Staffing Implications

The Act will not give rise to any additional staffing requirements.
