4a In page 12, before section 5, to insert the following new section:

“5.—The appointed day for the purpose of this Act shall be 1 July 2011.”.

8a In page 15, subsection (1), between lines 2 and 3, to insert the following:

“(g) to develop policies in relation to combatting the high levels of salary and pensions of senior employees of public service bodies and of excluded bodies, and

(h) to maintain a published record of all purchase orders in respect of the procurement of goods and services by and on behalf of Departments of State and other public service bodies.”.

8b In page 15, between lines 9 and 10, to insert the following subsection:

“(3) In carrying out his functions in relation to the processing tasks of public service bodies, the Minister shall lay details before the Oireachtas in all cases where he proposes self-contained areas of processing tasks that could be considered for transfer to the private sector.”.

8c In page 15, between lines 9 and 10, to insert the following subsection:

[SECTION 9]

“(3) In carrying out his functions in relation to the processing tasks of public service bodies, the Minister shall not identify or propose self-contained areas of processing tasks that could be considered for outsourcing/transfer to the private sector.”.

SECTION 10

9a In page 15, before section 10, to insert the following new section:

“10.—By 1 September 2011, the Minister shall lay a report before Dáil Éireann setting out a list of matters spanning the remit of Departments and Public Bodies which have the scope to generate substantial savings. This shall include matters such as subsidised publicly provided transport, social housing supports, procurement policy and the implementation of shared services/outsourcing.”.
