5. In page 6, between lines 6 and 7, to insert the following:		
"(6) (a) Where a person is not prosecuted under <i>subsection</i> (1) solely by virtue of the fact that it would not constitute an offence in the place in which it was done, then the Minister for Justice shall be informed of this fact.		
(b) On receiving such information under paragraph (a) the Minister for Justice shall, where the person is not a citizen of Ireland or a European Union citizen as defined by Council Directive 2004/38/EC, shall immediately initiate proceedings under section 3 of the Immigration Act		
1999.".		—Denis Naughten.
6. In page 6, between lines 12 and 13, to insert the following:		
 "6.—A person shall be guilty of an offence if the person aids, abets or incites a girl or woman to do to herself an act of female genital mutilation.". —Caoimhghín Ó Caoláin 		
7. In page 11, between lines 13 and 14, to insert the following:		
"15.—The Minister shall, not later than 5 years after the establishment day, carry out a review of the operation of this Act and shall make a report to each House of the Oireachtas of his or her findings and conclusions resulting from the review.". —Caoimhghín Ó Caoláin.
