

# AN BILLE UM THRÁCHT AR BHÓITHRE, 2013 ROAD TRAFFIC BILL 2013

## EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

### General

The purpose of the Bill is to make it an indictable offence for the driver of a vehicle involved in a road traffic accident to leave the scene of the accident in circumstances where a person is injured. The Bill extends the power of arrest of An Garda Síochána to include all hit and run road traffic accidents, regardless of whether or not a personal injury is involved.

#### Section 1

Definitions.

# **Section 2**

This section creates a new indictable offence for all hit and run road traffic accidents in circumstances where a person sustains personal injury. The punishment for this offence is a fine of up to €5,000 or a prison sentence of up to 10 years or to both.

## **Section 3**

This section extends the power of arrest of An Garda Síochána to arrest without warrant, the driver of a vehicle involved a hit a run road traffic accident, regardless of whether or not a person is injured.

# **Section 4**

This section makes provision to allow the Minister to make regulations pursuant to the Act.
