AN ACT TO AMEND THE CENTRAL BANK AND FINAN-CIAL SERVICES AUTHORITY OF IRELAND ACT 2004 10 TO ENABLE THE FINANCIAL SERVICE OMBUDSMAN TO INVESTIGATE COMPLAINTS IN RELATION TO THE SALE OF FINANCIAL PRODUCTS WITHIN THREE YEARS OF THE CONSUMER BECOMING AWARE FOR THE FIRST TIME THAT THE PRODUCT WAS 15 DEFECTIVE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE OIREACHTAS AS FOLLOWS:

1.—Section 57BX of the Central Bank Act 1942 (as inserted by Amendment of section 16 of the Central Bank and Financial Services Authority of section 57BX of Ireland Act 2004) is hereby amended by the substitution of subsec- Central Bank Act 20 tion (3) with the following subsection:

- "(3) A consumer is not entitled to make a complaint if the conduct complained of—
 - (a) is or has been the subject of legal proceedings before a Court or a Tribunal, or
 - (b) relates to a matter that is within the jurisdiction of the Pensions Ombudsman, or
 - (c) is of a class prescribed by Council Regulations, or
 - (d) occurred more than three years from the date on which the consumer first knew or in the circumstances ought reasonably to have known that the conduct of which complaint is made was attributable to the conduct of the Financial Service Provider.".
- 2.—(1) This Act may be cited as the Central Bank and Financial Short title and citation. Services Authority of Ireland (Amendment) Act 2013.

- (2) This Act shall not apply to any complaint made to the Financial Service Ombudsman before its passing.
- (3) The Central Bank and Financial Services Authority of Ireland Act 2004 and this Act shall be construed as one, and may be cited together as the Central Bank and Financial Services Authority of 5 Ireland Acts 2004 to 2013.
