Leasuithe Amendments

SECTION 1

1. In page 3, line 13, after “boat” where it firstly occurs to insert “or a boat used for the purposes of aquaculture”.

2. In page 3, between lines 15 and 16, to insert the following:

“(2) Fishing for mussel seed will be excluded from the activities pertaining to fishing within this Act and will be considered a resource fixed to the sea bed thereby categorically differentiated from mobile fish stocks.”.

3. In page 3, line 16, to delete “owned and operated” and substitute “of which the beneficial owner(s) are person(s) resident”.

4. In page 3, line 17, after “Ireland” to insert “by persons resident in Northern Ireland or the Republic of Ireland”.

6. In page 3, lines 19 to 22, to delete all words from and including “if,” in line 19 down to and including “boat” in line 22.

7. In page 3, to delete lines 23 to 33, and in page 4, to delete lines 1 to 4.

8. In page 4, between lines 4 and 5, to insert the following:

“(g) an obligation on the Minister to bring forward and implement an All-Ireland sustainability and conservation management plan for non-quota species within the 0 to 6 mile limits.”.

9. In page 4, between lines 5 and 6, to insert the following:

“(5) Any vessel availing of the access permitted under this Act shall only be entitled to fish for a quota or allocation of any species set in accordance with the quota or allocation available to them from the stock for that species in their home jurisdiction.”.

10. In page 4, between lines 5 and 6, to insert the following:

“(5) No provisions of this Act shall apply to the contracting parties under the London Fisheries Convention outside of the Republic of Ireland and the North of Ireland.”.
