An Act to recognise the meeting of the First Dáil and the Declaration of Independence made on 21 January 1919 and to provide for a “Declaration of Independence Day” to be held on 21 January annually and to provide for related matters. 5

Be it enacted by the Oireachtas as follows:

Definitions

1. In this Act— 10
- “Declaration of Independence” means the formal Declaration of Independence issued by the members of Dáil Éireann on 21 January 1919;
- “First Dáil” means the meeting in the Round Room of the Mansion House, Dublin 2 on 21 January 1919, at which Dáil Éireann was constituted and asserted the exclusive right of the elected representatives of the Irish people to legislate for the country; 15
- “Minister” means the Minister for Arts, Heritage, Regional, Rural and Gaeltacht Affairs;
- “public holiday” is defined as per the Holiday (Employees) Act 1973.

Declaration of Independence Day

2. (1) A formal State recognition of the Declaration of Independence shall be made with the designation of 21 January as “Declaration of Independence Day”. 20
- (2) Each year, irrespective of what day it falls upon, 21 January will be commemorated by the State as “Declaration of Independence Day”, however the day will not be classified as a public holiday.

Short title and commencement

3. (1) This Act may be cited as the Declaration of Independence Day Act 2017. 25
- (2) This Act shall come into operation on the date of its passing.

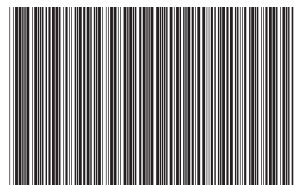
