An Act to amend the National Monuments Acts 1930 to 2014 for the purpose of deeming certain parts of Moore Street, and its environs, in the City of Dublin to be a national monument for the purposes of those Acts; and to provide for related matters.

**Be it enacted by the Oireachtas as follows:**

## **Amendment of Part IV of National Monuments Act 1930**

10

1. The National Monuments Act 1930 is amended in Part IV by inserting the following section after section 19:

### **“Moore Street Battlefield deemed to be a national monument**

**19A.** (1) The Moore Street Battlefield is deemed to be a national monument for the purposes of the National Monuments Acts 1930 to 2014 and, accordingly, the definition of ‘national monument’ in section 2 of this Act shall be construed as including a reference to the Moore Street Battlefield.

(2) In this section ‘Moore Street Battlefield’ means—

(a) the thoroughfares in the City of Dublin of Moore Street between Henry Street and Parnell Street and of Henry Place between Henry Street and Moore Street,

(b) the buildings, which for the purposes of this paragraph include their outhouses, yards and rear structures, that comprised the terrace of houses known as Numbers 10 to 25 Moore Street in the City of Dublin and were occupied and held during April 1916 as the last headquarters of the 1916 Provisional Government of the Irish Republic, and

(c) all buildings and their fabric that lined and comprised the route taken through Henry Place to Moore Street in the City of Dublin by volunteers upon their evacuation of the General Post Office in that City,

and, where any such building (including any part of it) as referred to in paragraph (b) or (c) is not extant on the date of the passing of the

National Monuments (The Moore Street Battlefield) Act 2018, includes the site of any such building or part.”.

**Short title, collective citation and construction**

2. (1) This Act may be cited as the National Monuments (The Moore Street Battlefield) Act 2018.
- (2) The National Monuments Acts 1930 to 2014 and this Act may be cited together as the National Monuments Acts 1930 to 2018 and shall be construed together as one.
