Leasuithe Amendments

**Government amendments are denoted by an asterisk*

1. In page 5, lines 19 and 20, to delete all words from and including “Betting” in line 19 down to and including line 20 and substitute the following:

“Betting Act 1931;

‘remote gaming’ means gaming in which persons participate by the use of remote communication;

‘remote gaming machine’ means any instrument of gaming which is facilitated by remote communication;

‘remote communication’ means communication using—

- (a) internet,
- (b) telephone,
- (c) television,
- (d) radio, or
- (e) any other kind of electronic or other technology for facilitating communication;”.

2. In page 7, between lines 13 and 14, to insert the following:

“(b) A person who holds a gaming permit shall not provide gaming services between the hours of 4 a.m. and 7 a.m.”.

3. In page 7, line 14, to delete “(b) A person” and substitute the following:

“(c) A person”.

4. In page 7, line 16, to delete “(c) Where” and substitute the following:

“(d) Where”.

5. In page 8, between lines 21 and 22, to insert the following:

“Repeal of sections 12, 13 and 15(6) of Principal Act

5. Sections 12, 13 and 15(6) of the Principal Act are repealed.”.

6. In page 18, to delete lines 6 and 7 and substitute the following:

“24. (1) Sections 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 12, 13, 15(6), 21, 22, 22A, 23, 24, 25, 27, 28A, 29, 31, 34, and 45 of the Principal Act are repealed.”.

7. In page 20, between lines 13 and 14, to insert the following:

“(2) Section 7 of the Betting Act 1931 is amended by the insertion of the following section after section 7E:

“Condition attaching to licences issued under the Act of 1931

7F. (1) This section applies to any bookmaker’s licence, remote bookmaker’s licence and remote betting intermediary’s licence issued under this Act.

(2) A licence to which this section applies shall, by virtue of this subsection, be subject to the condition that nothing may be done, either directly or indirectly, in reliance on such licence in relation to any bet on the outcome or results of a lottery game.

(3) Subsection (2) shall apply to all licences, including a licence issued before this section comes into force, with effect from the date on which this section is commenced.

(4) In this section, the term ‘lottery game’ has the meaning given to such term under the National Lottery Act 2013.”.

(3) Section 16 of the Betting Act 1931 is amended by the substitution of the following for subsection (2)(b):

“(b) the holder of a licence under this Act has contravened sections 7D, 7E, 7F or 23.”.
