An Act to amend the Merchant Shipping (Investigation of Marine Casualties) Act 2000, to revise the requirements for composition of the Marine Casualty Investigation Board and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Oireachtas as follows:

Definition

1. In this Act “Act of 2000” means the Merchant Shipping (Investigation of Marine Casualties) Act 2000.

Amendment of section 9 of Act of 2000

2. Section 9(1) of the Act of 2000 is amended by substitution of “Subject to section 9A, the Board shall consist of” for “The Board shall consist of”. 15

Qualification of members of Board

3. The Act of 2000 is amended by inserting the following section after section 9:

“Qualification of members of Board

9A. (1) Where the Minister—

- (a) appoints a person to the Board in accordance with section 9(1)(a),
or
- (b) re-appoints a person to the Board in accordance with paragraph (a)
or (b) of section 10(1),

the Minister shall have regard to the desirability of the persons appointed having appropriate knowledge, qualifications or experience in matters connected to the functions of the Board. 25

- (2) Where the Secretary General of the Department of Transport, Tourism and Sport nominates a further person to the Board in accordance with section 14(4), the Secretary General shall have regard to the desirability of the persons appointed having appropriate knowledge, 30

qualifications or experience in matters connected to the functions of the Board.”.

Short title, collective citation and construction

4. (1) This Act may be cited as Merchant Shipping (Investigation of Marine Casualties) (Amendment) Act 2019. 5
- (2) The Merchant Shipping Acts 1894 to 2015 and this Act may be cited together as the Merchant Shipping Acts 1894 to 2019 and shall be construed together as one.
- (3) The Maritime Safety Acts 1992 to 2006 and this Act may be cited together as the Maritime Safety Acts 1992 to 2019.
