“(5) Before any evidence or document is deposited with the specified Minister in accordance with subsection (2) of section 43 of the Act of 2004 the Commission shall redact from any such evidence or document given to the confidential committee any reference to the name of or any other information which might serve to identify any third party living or deceased who is the subject of any untested or unproven claims or allegations contained therein where such claims or allegations concern an illegal act or would otherwise in the view of the Commission be injurious to the reputation of that third party.”.
