#### *Leasuithe Amendments*

---

1. In page 9, after line 40, to insert the following:

#### **“Legislation for a new Marine Accident Investigation Unit**

16. The Minister shall, within six months of the passing of this Act, bring forward legislation to Dáil Éireann providing for the establishment of a new Marine Accident Investigation Unit, taking into consideration the recommendations of the Lacey Report, the Clinch Report and the pre-legislative scrutiny report from the Joint Committee on Transport and Communications on the Merchant Shipping (Investigation of Marine Casualties) (Amendment) Bill 2021, and any other relevant information/submissions the Minister deems appropriate.”.

2. In page 9, after line 40, to insert the following:

#### **“Publication of the Clinch Report**

16. The Minister shall, within seven days of the passing of this Act, publish the report authored by Clinchmaritime Ltd., known as the Clinch Report, that was received by the Department of the Environment, Climate and Communications in July 2021.”.

3. In page 9, after line 40, to insert the following:

#### **“Publication of the Lacey Report**

16. The Minister shall, within seven days of the passing of this Act, publish the Lacey Report, authored by Roisin Lacey in 2010.”.

4. In page 9, after line 40, to insert the following:

**“Report on the establishment of a Marine Accident Investigation Unit**

16. The Minister shall, within three months of the passing of this Act, prepare and lay before the Joint Committee on Transport and Communications, a report detailing the progress of the establishment of a new Marine Accident Investigation Unit.”.
