

ERRATUM SLIP

International Protection Bill 2026

As passed by Dáil Éireann

For the information of Members, please note that the printed version of the above Bill, as passed by Dáil Éireann on 25 February, 2026, contains an error in section 22.

Due to an administrative error in the Bills Office, Committee Stage amendment number 22, which was negated following a division of the Dáil, was carried forward into the *as passed by Dáil Éireann* version of the Bill. This administrative error has resulted in a paragraph (f) being mistakenly inserted into subsection (6) of section 22 of the Bill, contrary to the decision of the House. Please see an extract of the Bill below, with the relevant text highlighted in red.

(iv) who is subject to surrender under section 33 or 33A of that Act,	30
