HSE Responses to issues for follow up from meeting of PAC held on 8th November 2012

7) A note on the payment of a travel and subsistence allowance to staff employed by the HSE. Total amount paid in respect of this allowance and amount paid by breakdown of staff grade to be included

Response:

Travel and Subsistence

Employees who are required to travel on official business away from their headquarters and employees assigned to field duties will be paid the travel and subsistence rates approved by the Department of Health and Children. Travelling and subsistence allowances are payable only in respect of necessary absences from headquarters. The expenses concerned must have been incurred 'wholly exclusively and necessarily' in the performance of the duties of the employment.

The HSE is responsible for the reimbursement of Travel and Subsistence expenses for journeys undertaken by staff in the performance of their duties in accordance with Circular 11/1982 (Travelling and Subsistence Regulations), Circular 18/2006(Subsistence Allowances) and the National Financial Regulations NFR-05.

Examples of grades of staff who are paid Travel and Subsistence are:

- > Public Health Nurses
- > Social Workers
- > Home Helps
- > Registrars
- > Occupational Therapists
- > Physiotherapists

Both Finance -Accounts Payable and Payroll systems are used for the settlement of this expense. Five different systems are currently in use across the former health board areas for the processing of travel and subsistence expenses. The Accounts Payable system does not record grade codes.

The Table below sets out the travel and subsistence paid to the various grades of staff through the payroll system and accounts payable system.

The staff figure of *4,370 in the table below relates to staff (3,364) in the North East Area of HSE DNE and staff (1,006) in HSE West and HSE South who are paid Travel and Subsistence through accounts payable. While it's not possible to break down these numbers into the 6 categories as per the table, the staff paid do fall into these categories.

 These staff are paid through accounts payable and include staff from each of the 6 categories above.
