Dear Mr McEnery,

I refer to your letter of 21 September, 2012, which requested details of (i) general civil service wide allowances and (ii) all civil service allowances paid in the Department of Public Expenditure and Reform and the bodies under its aegis. All business cases submitted for review in relation to these allowances are published on the Departments' website www.per.gov.ie.

The information requested in your letter in relation to (i) is set out across two separate tables in Appendix 1 to this letter: a Common Civil Service Allowances table and a Common Additional Hours table. These tables give detailed information on the allowances paid to staff in more than two Civil Service Departments/ Offices in 2011 and were compiled from information supplied by Government Departments and Offices.

The information in relation to (ii) is set out in a table in Appendix 2. This table shows the allowances currently being paid to certain staff in the Department of Public Expenditure and Reform and the number of current recipients. Also shown are the costs for each of these allowances in 2011 and the range of payments made to the relevant staff. In many cases rates of payment may differ as the rate may be determined by the grade, point of pay or period covered by the claim. As the Department of Public Expenditure and Reform was established in July 2011 the total cost 2011 figures for the Department only cover the period from July to December 2011. Many of these are common service allowances and the data in respect of these allowances has been included in the table at Appendix 2.

Please note that the Employee Assistance Officer (EAO) Allowance is not included in the Common Civil Service Allowance table as it ceased to be a common allowance with effect from 20 January, 2012 when the Civil Service Employee Assistance Service (CSEAS) became a centralised service within this Department and 10 EAOs transferred into this Department from other Departments on that date. During 2011 there were approximately 12.5 EAOs based in various Civil Service Departments covering the EAO function for the entire Civil Service. There was no EAO based in this Department in 2011. The cost of the EAO allowance for the entire Civil Service in 2011 was approximately €72,800. A business case was submitted and approved for payment of the Employee Assistance Officer allowance to new beneficiaries.

Under the Review of Allowances and Premium Payments, Departments were not required to submit business cases for allowances that are held on a personal-to-holder basis or for allowances that are not available to any new beneficiary. Details of such allowances are not included in the Common Civil Service Allowance table.
