RIA Population figures

Current Population

- Total applicants in RIA accommodation – 6497 (517 are in emergency hotel accomm)

Occupancy increases

- 15% in 2017,
- 20% in 2018,
- 6% in quarter one 2019

Emergency Accommodation

- 517 - 424 adults - 88 children (49 of whom are school going age 5-18)
