Tuesday proposal no. 3 - Motion re the Situation in Belarus

- Shall be brought to a conclusion after 145 minutes, with arrangements in accordance with those agreed by Order of the Dáil of 30 July 2020, for 135 minutes, following which a Minister or Minister of State may make a speech in reply which shall not exceed 10 minutes, and all members may share time
