<u>Departmental Response to PAC</u> **2019 Accounts of the Heritage Council**

- The Comptroller & Auditor General's certificate in respect of the Heritage Council's 2019 Financial Statements was dated 23 December 2020 and it was issued to the Heritage Council on 15 January 2021.
- On receipt of the C&AG's certificate on 15 January 2021, the Heritage Council engaged the graphic designer to incorporate the financial statement into the Annual Report however there was a delay with this and it took until 27 February to be cleared by the CEO and sent to the Department. The Heritage Council acknowledges that this is longer than the month provided for in the Circular 7/2015 (Section 4) and that it should have filed the accounts with the Department as soon as possible and within one month rather than waiting until they were incorporated into the Annual Report.
- The 2019 Annual Report was submitted to the Department on 27 February 2021 and was laid before the Houses of the Oireachtas on 11 May 2021. This is within the 3 months provided for in Circular 7/2015 (Section 5) where the Agency's Annual Report must first be brought to Government.
- The Department's business unit with responsibility for the Heritage Council is making arrangements to send a copy of the accounts to the Public Accounts Committee (per Circular 7/2015 (Section 9)) this week.
