The role of the Department of Agriculture, Food and the Marine in relation to animal Re:

welfare at Dublin Zoo

Please find below a note on the above topic.

In relation to zoos, the National Parks and Wildlife Service (Department of Housing, Local Government and Heritage) is responsible for zoo inspections under the EC (Licensing and Inspection of Zoos) Regulation, 2003.

In relation to Dublin Zoo, routine licensing inspections are carried out by the National Park and Wildlife Service which has responsibility for regulation of zoos in Ireland.

Veterinary personnel from the Department of Agriculture, Food and the Marine attend at Dublin zoo, as required, to issue official health certification for animals being exported from Dublin zoo to other countries. The Department has a regulatory role in the trade of zoo animals moving to approved zoos (confined establishments). This role is principally related to the animal health risks posed by such trade.
